WORLD SHOW AND CELEBRATION - Ava, Missouri September 6-12, 2020

He gave her a great initial 30 days, she proved to be level headed and willing. When I returned to Illinois in April I found some great Versatility trainers in Missouri, Mike and Joy Meizler. Bella went to their training barn in June for 90 days of training. I owe a lot of my experience at Ava to the



Meizler's. They walked me through the process and were with me every step of the way.
